In the chair presiding was the Honorable Mayor Jim Brown and the following City Commissioners were present: Jamie Powell, Wendell Stewart, Henry Stone, Herbert Williams. Also present were City Attorney Scott Crabtree; City Finance Director Cendy Dodd; and a media representative, Keith Pyles, from the Franklin Favorite/WFKN.

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 6:12 p.m. and Commission Wendell Stewart offered an opening prayer.

At 7:00 p.m. **Motion** was made by Commissioner Powell and seconded by Commissioner Stewart to exit executive session and return to open session. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Powell and seconded by Commissioner Stewart to hire Kevin Dukes in the Public Works Department at a rate of \$12.00 per hour plus normal full time benefits. Ayes: All. Motion carried. Mr. Dukes has been working in the Public Works department as a temporary, part-time employee.


