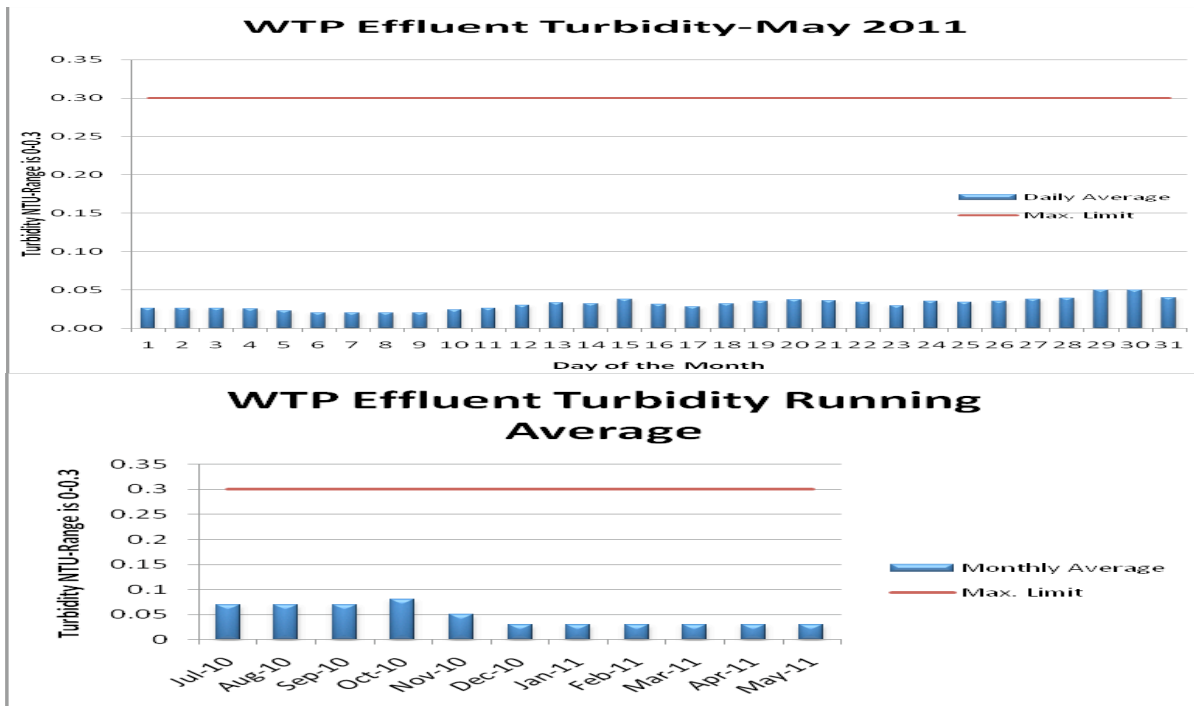
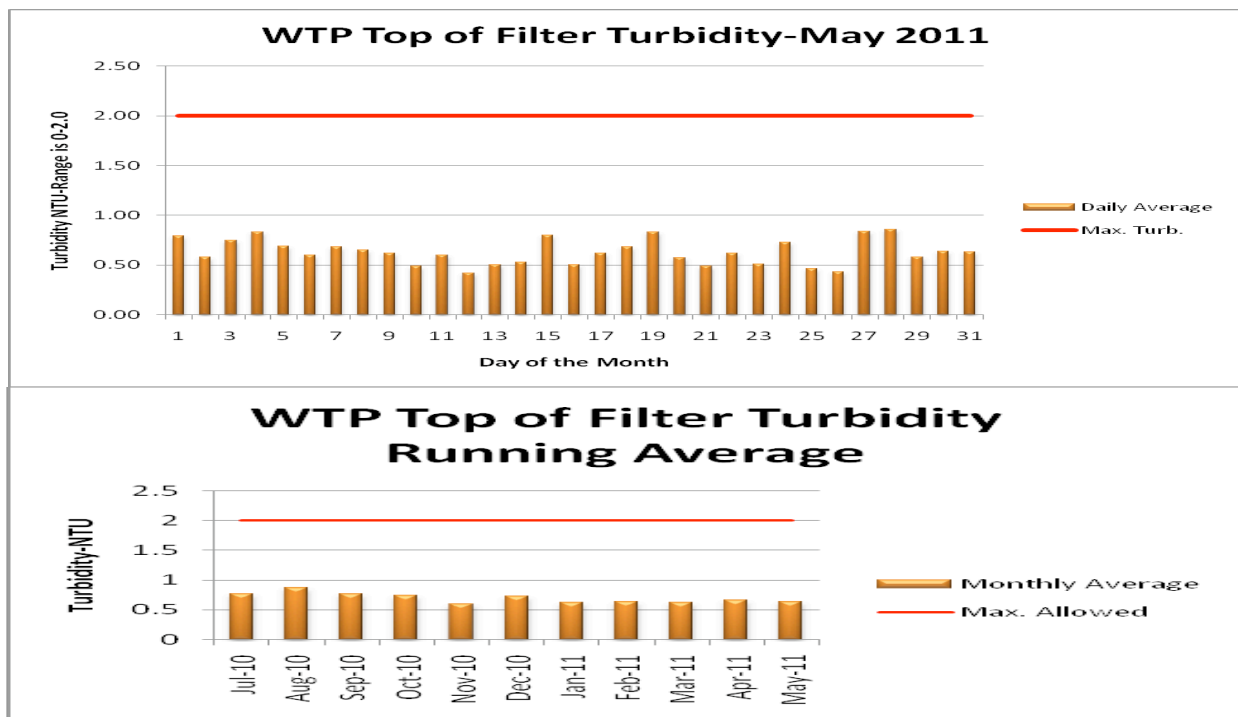


Water Treatment Plant

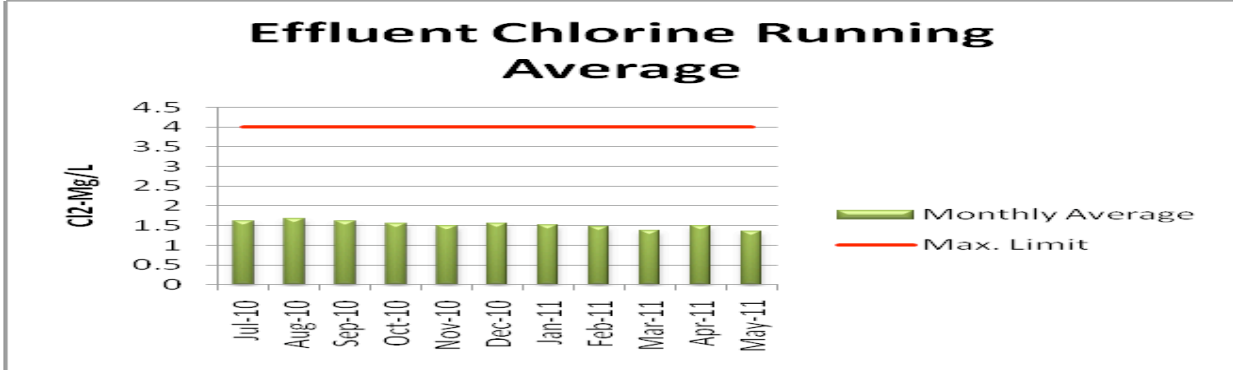
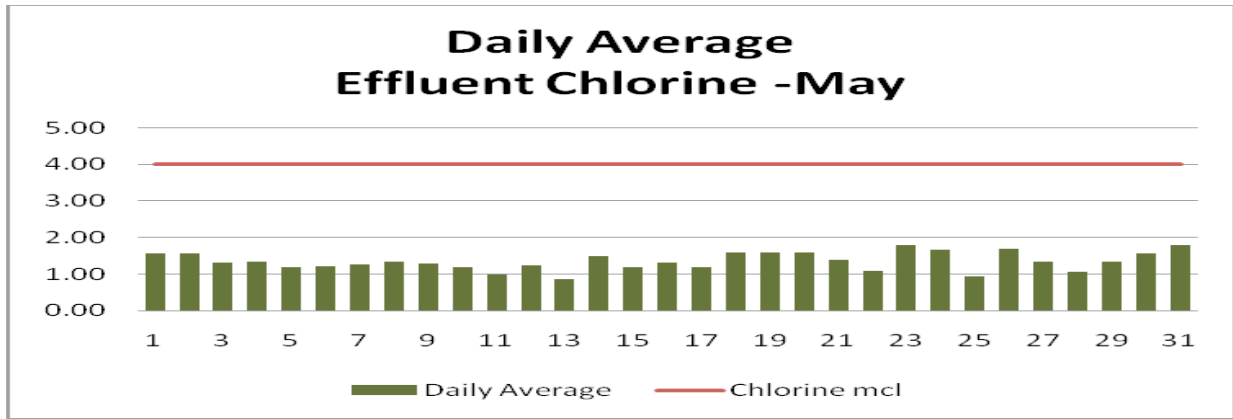


▶ Effluent is the term for the Finished Water Leaving the Plant. Turbidity is the Measurement of the Clarity of the Water.

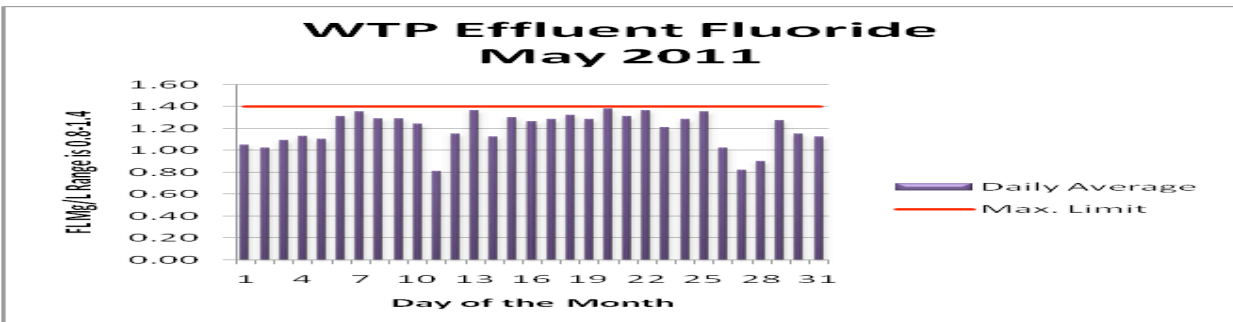


◀ The "Top of Filter" Turbidity is the Measurement during the Treatment Process.

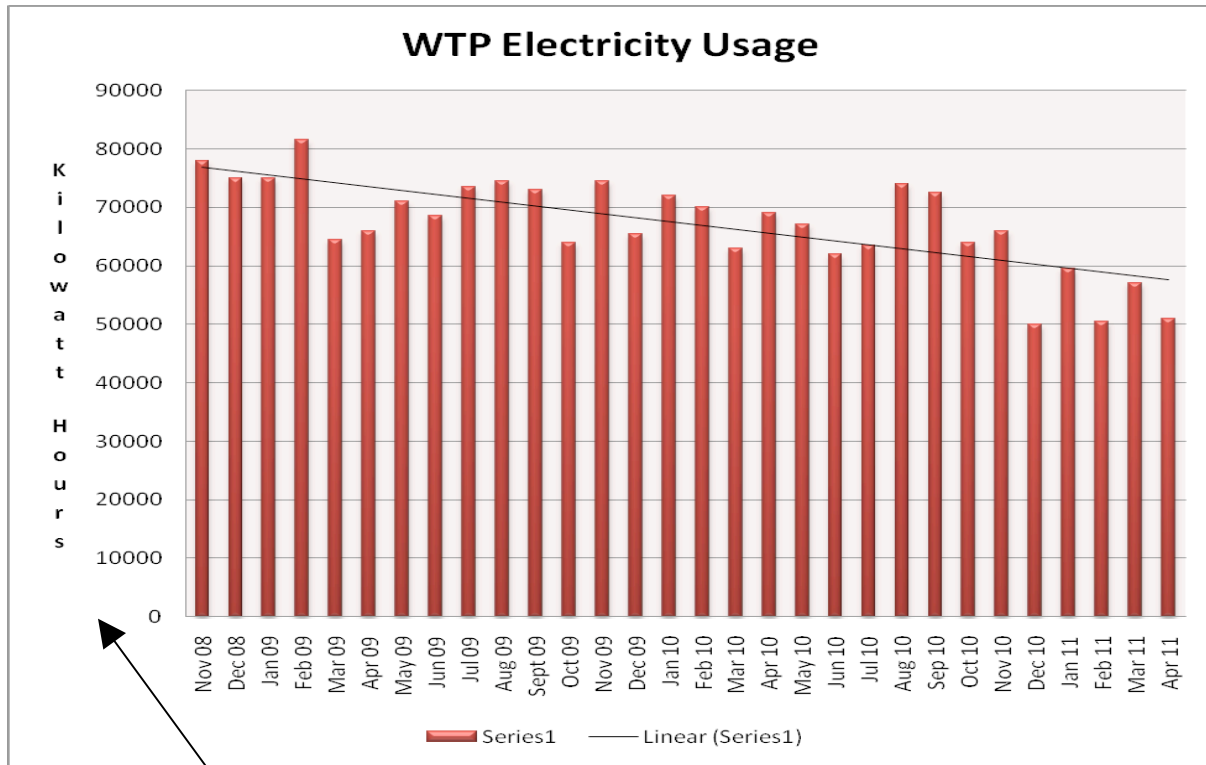


Chlorine is Used for Disinfection
