## **ORDINANCE 2017-005**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2016 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2017 BY ESTIMATING REVENUES AND APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, the City Commission for the City of Franklin, Kentucky is required by law to amend its budget ordinance to reflect actual revenues and expenditures if different from those projected; and

WHEREAS, it has been reported to the City Commission that actual revenues collected and costs expended by the city during the 2016-2017 fiscal year are different from those projected in the current budget ordinance, and it is therefore necessary to amend the 2016-2017 budget ordinance to reflect these variances,

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it ordained by the City of Franklin, Kentucky that the 2016-2017 budget is hereby amended to read as follows:
